



## Questions to ask and things to look out for!

### Ofsted

- Can I have a copy of your latest inspection report, since your last inspection what improvements have you made?
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- How do you maintain ratios to cover staff breaks and sickness?
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- What information do I need to give you and what information can I expect in return?
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### Recommendations

- Does your child look forward to going each time?
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- How happy are you with the care, do the children seem happy and occupied?
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- Would you recommend this nursery to me, why?
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### Staff

- How many staff are qualified to NVQ level 3 or equivalent, how many have first aid training?

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- What is the staff turnover like?

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- Does the staff seem happy and are they engaging with the children?

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### **Nursery Education**

- How will you assess my child and monitor their progress?

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- How can I be involved with their education?

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- Is there evidence of the children's activities and creations around the nursery, on walls/sides etc?

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### **Nursery Setting**

- What is their security policy and how do they ensure the right person collects the children?

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- Is there an outdoor area for play and how often is it used?

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- Is it clean and well presented, are the toys clean and in good repair?
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**Flexibility**

- What are the opening hours and nursery sessions?
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- Can my child attend hours outside of the sessions?
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- Can I swap my sessions if necessary?
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
